DESCRIPTION OF THE TOUR:

This visit starts in search of Blue Rock Thrush in streams in limestone foothills close to the Sierra de Ayllón. Most abundant in this area are dotted with patches of Mediterranean forests and Rock Roses that shelter a wide variety of birds. No wonder to behold the Golden Eagles flying over this area.

Then we remount the Jarama River being a small canyon where Kingfishers, various Warblers, Grag Martins and Rock Buntings find a good shelter to live.

We end the tour at the Jarama Valley in cereal plains searching Great Bustards and other steppe birds. Overflying these fields we might find Black Vultures, Eurasian Mars, Hen and Montagu's Harriers, Merlins, among others. It also highlights as a good place to observe several species of Larks.

TARGET SPECIES:

White Stork, Griffon and Black Vultures, Eurasian Mars, Hen and Montagu's Harriers, Black and Red Kites, Northern Goshawk, Booted, Golden and Short-toed Eagles, Lesser and Common Kestrels, Little and Great Bustards, Black-bellied Sandgrouses, European Bee-eater, Eurasian Hoopoe, Common Kingfisher, Red-rumped Swallow, Crested, Short-toed and Calandra Larks, Woodchat and Southern Grey Shrikes, Golden Oriole, Azure-winged Magpie, Red-billed Chough, Rock Bunting, among others. Sightings of listed species depends on the year's time of the visit.
